W5 (H7) Mu'adh b. Jabal (may Allah be pleased with him) said:

The Messenger of Allah was detained one morning from observing the prayer with us till the sun had almost appeared over the horizon. He then faced us and explained, "Let me tell you what kept me from you this morning. I got up at night, performed my ablution, and prayed as much as was written for me. I happened to doze off whilst in prayer and then fell into a deep sleep. At that moment, I saw my Lord in the most beautiful form. He said, 'O Muhammad,' I replied, 'At Your service, my Lord.' He asked, 'What are the angels near My presence debating about?' I replied, 'I don't know.' He asked me this three times. Then I saw Him place His palm between my shoulder blades, and I felt the coolness of his fingertips on my chest. Thus, everything became manifestly clear, and I knew it."

He said, 'O Muhammad,' I replied, 'At Your service, my Lord.' He asked, 'What are the angels near My presence debating about?' I replied, 'Expiation.' He asked, 'What are they?' and I replied, 'Walking on foot to the congregational prayers, sitting in the mosques after the prayers are over, and performing complete ablution in difficult circumstances.'
