3. Hadith Qudsī from other Prophets.

(H3) Abu Sa'īd (May Allah be pleased with him) narrated:

The Messenger of Allah in narrated that Noah and his followers will appear on the Day of Resurrection. Allah will inquire of Noah, "Did you deliver the Message?' He will respond, 'Yes, O my Lord!' Subsequently, Allah will question Noah's nation, 'Did Noah deliver My Message to you?' They will reply, 'No prophet came to us.' Then Allah will ask Noah, 'Who will serve as a witness for you?' He will answer, 'Muhammad and his followers will serve as witnesses for me.' Consequently, my followers and I will act as witnesses for him, affirming that he conveyed Allah's Message. This explanation aligns with the interpretation of Allah's statement: "Thus we have made you a just and the best nation that you might be witnesses over mankind."

(H4) Abu Huraira narrated:

The Prophet stated, "On the Day of Resurrection, Abraham will encounter his father Azar, whose face will be marked with blackness and dust. He will inquire whether Azar did not previously advise him against disobedience. His father will respond that he now intends to obey him, to which Abraham will say, 'My Lord, You have promised that I will not be disgraced on the day when all men are resurrected. But what greater shame could there be than my father being the furthest from Your mercy?' God Most High will reply, 'I have barred the disbelievers from Paradise.' Subsequently, Abraham will be instructed to look beneath his feet, where he will see a hyena covered in dirt and hair. This creature will then be seized by its legs and cast into Hell." Abraham's father will be transformed into the form of a hyena so that Abraham will not witness his being cast into Hell in his original form.
